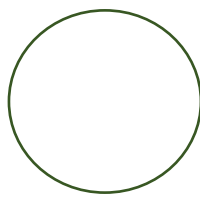
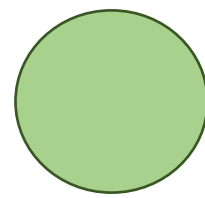
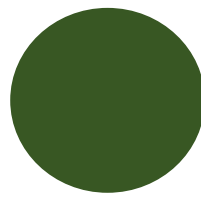


# French



## Intent

At Trinity and St. Michaels our aim is to revise our approach in order to create a new culture for language learning, with all staff and pupils enjoying a sense of 'learning and discovering together', regardless of their prior knowledge of languages. Although the national curriculum only sets out a Key Stage 2 Programme of Study, we are keen as a school to introduce early language learning from Key Stage 1.
