Spring Term Year 2

Topic - 'How to train your Dragon'

English

This half term our class texts will be Dragon Machine by Helen Ward and Dragonsitter by Josh Lacey. We will also be using the film 'How to train your Dragon' to assist our adventure writing and some additional texts.

Phonics and Reading

We will continue to have a daily phonics/spelling session and a weekly grammar and punctuation lesson. The children will be given spellings and we will have our spelling focused activity on a Friday.

Reading books

Children are encouraged to read daily and with this in mind we ask that all children bring their current reading book into school each day. Children should read their book three times. The first read as a vocabulary and word recognition activity, the second as a shared turn- taking read and finally a full read through.

Maths

In maths we will be exploring multiplication and division. We will also be exploring fractions, positional vocabulary and rotations.







Science

In Science we will be looking at humans and other animals, exercise and survival. Topics will include living and non-living, life cycles and food chains.

Geography


