Topic

Maths

To start with, we will recap our knowledge of fractions before we can start to deepen our understanding further by exploring improper and proper fractions. We will use lots of physical resources available to help us visualise what fractions look like and of course lots of interactive Maths opportunities to get us active!

Next, we will look at recapping money and time. We will be solving problems all about money and the change we might get when buying lots of sweets!

Science

In Science, we will be exploring all about living things and their habitats as well as animals including humans. We will be looking at who eats who in the animal world and we will also conduct a disgusting investigation all about our digestive system (specifically how food moves from one end of the body to the other)!

Art/DT

This term we will start with Art, we will be learning about how to tell a story through art using illustrations! Then we will move on to DT, where will be looking at creating moving pictures using levers and linkages.

Music

In Music, you will gain your own musical instruments as we begin brass lessons. Whether you are an expert already or have never played before, we will be learning lots of fun tunes you can show off at home!

Computing

This term we will focus on developing our understanding about how we can use technology – specifically iMovie. This will mean we need to become film stars so we can edit and improve our videos.

How to help at home:

We will spend time daily, learning all the times tables up to 12x12, which the children will be tested on weekly.
